"The high plains never fully recovered from the Dust Bowl. The land came through the 1930s deeply scarred and forever changed, but in places, it healed...After more than 65 years, some of the land is still sterile and drifting. But in the heart of the old Dust Bowl now are three national grasslands run by the Forest Service.

## *The Impact of the Dust Bowl on the Environment*

Technically, the driest region of the Plains – southeastern Colorado, southwest Kansas and the panhandles of Oklahoma and Texas – became known as the Dust Bowl, and many dust storms started there. But the entire region, and eventually the entire country, was affected. The Dust Bowl got its name after Black Sunday, April 14, 1935.

## *The Dust Bowl of the 1930s - Living History Farm*

The Dust Bowl was a significant disaster for the United States, resulting in large economic and agricultural losses, farm abandonment, and a level of human migration that, in the recent historical period, is comparable only with the evacuation of New Orleans in 2005 ( 4, 10 ). However, the Dust Bowl differed in important ways from the canonical La Nina drought pattern ( Figs. 1 Left) ( 11 ).
